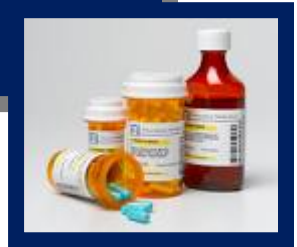

- 1 in 10 has abused cough medication.
- An estimated 10.4 million Americans aged 12 or older used methamphetamine at least once in their lifetime.
